2. LTTA Turkey

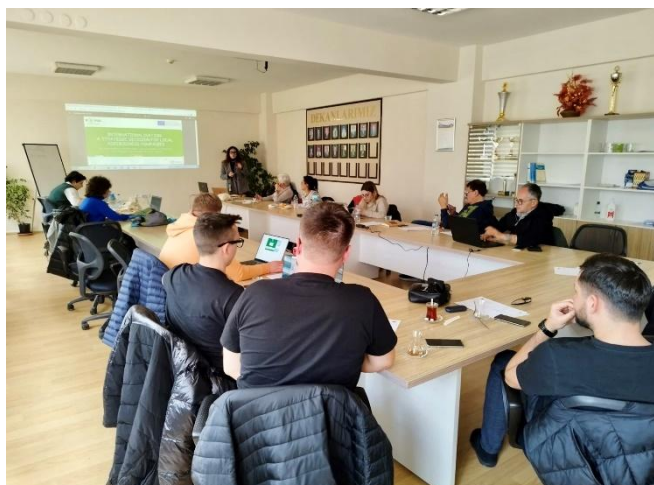
